

Our Campground Guidelines

THIS PROPERTY IS PRIVATELY OWNED. THE MANAGEMENT WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ACCIDENTAL INJURY TO OUR GUESTS OR LOSSES OF ANY KIND.
FOR EVERYONE'S FUN AND RELAXATION WE ASK THAT YOU OBSERVE THE FOLLOWING RULES.

1: Check-In, Check-Out:

A: Check-in time: 1 PM

B: Check-out time: 12:00 Noon Everyday (additional fee if late check out is needed)

2: Parents are responsible for their children at all times.

A: Children 13 and under must be accompanied by an adult when using the pool. **(STATE LAW)**

B. **NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY.**

C: Bike rentals require the signature of parent or guardian.

3: Quiet Hours:

10:00 PM to 8:00 AM: Minor children must be on their sites during quiet hours. No loud music at any time.

4: PETS:

A: **All PETS** must be kept quiet and on a short leash at all times, including your site.

B: **You are required to pick up after your pet.**


C: Please walk your pet in the grassy area along the outside fence.

D: Please do not tie pets to trees.

E: Pets are not allowed in any buildings or pool area.

F: **PET RESTRICTIONS:** By breed and by bark.

G: Do not leave your pet unattended in your camper or vehicle.



5: POOL:

The pool is intended for the enjoyment of all registered guests. Swimming devices and toys may be limited for the safety and well being of all our guests. Pool behavior will be monitored. Please observe posted rules. Failure to do so, will result in pool privileges being revoked for the remainder of your stay.

NO SMOKING inside fence line.

PLEASE BE COURTEOUS AND CONSIDERATE OF ALL SWIMMERS.

6: PLAYGROUND:

The playground closes at dusk. Please do not allow your children on the playground after dark.

7: Using washrooms, laundry or faucets for washing dishes is not permitted.

8: Do not dump gray water from RV's on the ground. This is against health regulations.

9: Place garbage in dumpsters. All garbage must be bagged and no outside garbage. No fish in the dumpsters.

10: **WE DO RECYCLE** aluminum, plastic, glass, newspaper, tin and cardboard.

A: Put plastic, glass, newspaper and tin in the marked containers.

B: Aluminum: Please place in the Large Barrels.

11: We ask that you **DO NOT**:

A: Wash your vehicles or campers in the campground.

B: Change oil or do other vehicle maintenance.

C: Tie clotheslines to trees.

D: Move fire rings.

E: Leave garbage in the fire rings. (This attracts unwanted pests.)

12: Alcohol and Drugs:

A: Disorderly conduct and intoxication and/or drug use will not be tolerated. Offender(s) will be required to leave immediately.

B: Underage consumption will not be tolerated.

Abusers will be reported to the Rice County Sheriff's Department.

13: Fireworks:

ALL Fireworks are strictly prohibited. Anyone caught discharging fireworks will be asked to leave.

14: **NO REFUNDS.**

15: Visitors:

A: Your friends and relatives are welcome to visit during your stay at Camp Faribo. **They must stop at the office, register and pay the posted fee per person per day daily visitor fee.**

B: All visitors are required to leave by quiet hours.

16: Please use a little common sense and be a good neighbor. Consideration and respect for people, places and things really cover everything. All public buildings or gathering areas are non smoking. Smoking is allowed in your specific campsite. **Your cooperation is expected and appreciated.**
